

Alvin Rowledge Bursary Award

The Atlantic Golf Superintendents Association (AGSA) has established the Alvin Rowledge Bursary Award with the purpose of providing a \$1,000 (maximum) bursary annually to a qualified student (or students) registered in a sanctioned turfgrass program, at a recognized educational institute. This financial assistance is **meant for AGSA members** to become better qualified for their current employment or for other opportunities within the turfgrass maintenance profession.

The Alvin Rowledge Bursary will be administered by the AGSA Board of Directors. Preference will be given to those students currently enrolled, in at least, the second semester of a recognized turfgrass program spanning a minimum of (2 years). The Board will make their selection based on each student's academic standing, financial need and letters of reference. Letters of reference must demonstrate the applicant's sincere interest in the field of turfgrass maintenance.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Be a resident of Atlantic Canada
2. Be an AGSA member in good standing
3. have a minimum of (2) seasons as a golf course maintenance employee
4. Be presently enrolled in (at least) a 2 year program
5. Forward official transcripts of your academic record by registered mail to the AGSA Office
6. Have letters of recommendation from both: the golf course Superintendent at place of employment
a current turfgrass program instructor from the institution

Applicants are encouraged to submit more than just the minimum number of reference letters suggested.
